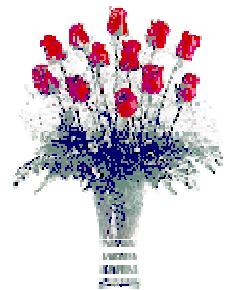

Skin Problems In Horses

There are many things that can affect a horse's skin. The list is long but a few are insect allergies along with fungal or bacterial infections. The skin is the body's largest and most important organ. It covers the entire exterior of the body and protects the inner organs. Although the skin is tough and resilient (and generally heals quickly) if it is compromised too much, the horse's health is at

risk. Skin problems can be minor or major but really should be checked by a vet, properly diagnosed and monitored to be sure they do not become serious.

Some skin issues are:

- Fungal Problems
- Pythiosis
- Parasites
- Skin Cancer
- Photosensitization
